Colleen McCarty Files for Tulsa County District Attorney with Broad Support from Business Leaders, Legislators, Crime Victims, and Grassroots Advocates



Tulsa, OK — Colleen McCarty has officially filed to run for Tulsa County District Attorney, launching a campaign centered on public safety, victim advocacy, and restoring integrity to the justice system. McCarty enters the race with strong early support from business leaders, elected officials, crime victims, and grassroots advocates across Tulsa County. While many campaigns rely on insider backing, McCarty’s coalition reflects a growing movement of Tulsans calling for transparency, accountability, and a justice system that works for everyone.

“This campaign is powered by the people of Tulsa County,” said McCarty. **“I’m running because too many families feel like they’re part of a transaction when they walk into the justice system. An Oklahoma attorney with years of legal and leadership experience, McCarty has built her campaign around strengthening public safety, prioritizing victims, enforcing ethical standards, and modernizing the DA’s office while respecting taxpayer dollars.
